Tucked away in an old, industrial building, this Belgian company is one of Europe's few remaining manufacturers of high end decorative hardware, their handcrafted, bespoke pieces range from handles for doors, windows and furniture, to any precious metal accessory that finishes your interior.

Since 1905, their masters-creators have been building an unparallel collection of more than 45 000 handcrafted pieces in numerous artistic styles, from Louis XVI to Art Deco to contemporary design. All pieces were created for projects all over the world, ranging from private residences, yachts and embassies

to royal palaces, auction houses and major museums.



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Our Craftman workshop creates exclusive decorative hardware in brass or bronze and favors bespoke and limited series. Every piece is handcrafted individually by our Craftsmen; whose passion is to create each day with extreme rigor unique pieces, luxury and real objects of art.

#### Handmade for hands


What is special about the products is the noble nature of the materials from which they are made, mostly allies such as brass and nickel silver.

Another rare feature is that they are made in their Brussels premises by twenty or so craftspeople, each of which specialized in one of the 17 manual processes that represent the production stages of an item. Once a piece has been poured and removed from the mould, the unfinished piece needs to go through a series of beautifying operations: Filing, engraving, adjusting, polishing and degreasing. All of these processes are transmitted and improved from generation to generation and, most surprisingly, all of the tools used are made by their own craftspeople, improved and adapted for each special case.

As final touch we offer the possibility to apply coatings on the initial material, no fewer than 20 shades each of which can be modulated from light to dark.




His simple, unpretentious, logical objects appeal as much on for their evident, clearly perceptible design as well as their discrete poetry.




"Euclide" is a structural, masculine and geometrical collection. The mixture of the round and square lines gives to the pieces a glimpse of clumsiness which makes them irresistibly adorable. The door handle collection is built with a circle inscribed in a square. In geometry, the incircle or inscribed circle of a polygon is the largest circle contained in this polygon; it touches and is tangent to the all sides. The center of the incircle is called the incenter.



### VINCENT VAN DUYSEN



Vincent Van Duysen was born in Lokeren, Belgium, in 1962, and undertook a degree in Architecture at the Higher Institute of Architecture Sint-Lucas, Ghent. Between 1986 and 1987 Van Duysen worked in Milan collaborating with Aldo Cibic – Sottsass Associati, after which, in 1990, he opened his studio in Antwerp specializing in architecture and interiors.

A strong relationship exists between Van Duysen's designs and his architectural projects - he chooses to develop furniture and objects from an architectural perspective - creating spatial relations rather than shapes. A rescaled interpretation of his architectural work, Van Duysen creates pieces that provide a sense of purity and essentialism, yet remaining tactile and grounded. Subsequently, many of the designs refer essential forms, tradition or well known masterpieces which Van Duysen redefines through a contemporary lens. A balance of form and proportion – without omitting durability, function, and comfort - is critical to the design process. The use of pure and tactile materials results in a clear and timeless design. An architectural language which is not shy of aesthetics, but resists fashion and trends. Van Duysen embraces these emotional aspects to celebrate 'the art of living'.





They design a variety of products and accessories for companies such as Alessi, Hay, Karimoku, Muji, Lexon, Nespresso and Moustache. BIG-GAME's work is often accessible, charming and, above all, useful. The studio has received numerous awards including the Swiss Design Award, the iF design award, the Wallpaper Design Award, the Good Design Award, the Hublot Design Award and Design Preis Schweiz. BIG-GAME's works are part of the collections of the Museum fur Gestaltung, the Musée du Grand-Hornu, the Centre Georges Pompidou as well as the MoMA.

The studio is based in Lausanne, Switzerland with a team of between five and seven people. In addition to their design work, the three founders of BIG-GAME also serve as professors at ECAL / University of Arts and Design Lausanne.






### STEPHANE PARMENTIER



The interior architect and designer Stéphane Parmentier began his career working for Karl Lagerfeld before deciding to devote himself to architecture full-time in 2002.

Since then, he has created and developed numerous projects for an international clientele attuned to his style of luxurious simplicity. The homes and objects he designs reveal a vision that is deeply anchored in a modern everyday lifestyle.

Inspired by classical Greco-Roman antiquity, the beauty of the Puglian landscape, the restraint of the Japanese aesthetic, and a desire to focus on the essential, he cultivates elegant asceticism by associating noble materials with substly graphic lines.



# STARDUST COLLECTION



For me, the Stardust collection is like the unification of a new movement that is so special and dear to the Maison Vervloet, whom I have known and appreciated for years. This new collection is like a meeting of elements that are simultaneously timeless, elegant, seemingly simple, graphic and a little industrial – a true technical challenge – and I hope, very personal.

The "double zero" that currently characterises some parts of my creations, symbolises for me the new birth of sharing and union, as two entities that meet and become one. This symbolism has been stretched, transformed and then riddled with perforations that play a dual role: aesthetics and practicality (a better grip).

The perforations waltz like new music or rhythmic movements over the various elements of the collection, which are completely interchangeable. I like this form of flexibility in the composition of a collection, an adaptability that embodies a new modernity for me. The two finishes also make it possible to transform the collection into two distinct but complementary universes: the dark patinated bronze symbolises the night and a universe full of mysteries and the polished brass finish evokes the memory of the heat of the sun and its rays.






